I would like to welcome you all back again to school after the long summer break. I hope you have all enjoyed some quality family time and that your children are pleased to be back with us. This first week has gone so quickly! All the children have made a fantastic start to the new school year, especially those who are joining us for the first time with a lovely atmosphere in school. New Extension and Building Work

I am sure you will all agree that the new extension looks very smart and makes a huge difference to the school. However, it also continues to bring us some challenges. Whilst we had the buildings handed over to us last week, the outdoor area has not been handed over yet as there is still quite a lot of work to be done. The Foundation Stage outdoor area is still waiting to be completed with rubber crumb, climbing frame and a new fence all to be fitted shortly. The Reception classrooms are also waiting for a fence to be built round the entrance.

This has meant we have had additional problems at home time this week with the top yard being fairly chaotic. I can only thank you for your patience as staff ensure children are handed safely over to their parents. I am in talks with the Local Authority as to how this area can be improved but it is going to take a little time. Meanwhile, Year 5 & 6 will be dismissed from the Junior Hall Door and Years 1-4 from the doors next to the main entrance.

Girls Football League – Monday 11th September

Our Year 5 & 6 girls football team have their first matches this Monday at Greenland Primary School. Mr Taylor will be selecting the team today but hopes that most Year 5 & 6 girls will have the opportunity to represent the school over the next few weeks. This has become a regular event and one which is welcomed by many parents. On Tuesday, after school, you will have the opportunity to get to know your child's new class teacher a little better at our 'Meet the Teacher' sessions. The meetings will last for about 15-20 minutes and take place in the classrooms. The teachers will be sharing information about the timetable and topics for their class, as well as giving you the chance to see your child's classroom and ask any questions you might have. The meetings take place at 3.45 pm and 4.30 pm – that way, if you have children in different classes, you will still be able to meet both of their teachers. We look forward to welcoming you all in school on Tuesday.

Sickness Policy

I would just like to take this opportunity of reminding parents of our policy when children have vomited. If your child has been sick, you MUST keep your child away from school for 48 hours. This is for the benefit of all, as I am sure you are aware just how quickly bugs can spread in establishments such as schools. It is also possible that if you send your child back to school too quickly, they can come down with the bug a second time. Please respect this policy which is in place for the benefit of all children and families. I realise that it can be awkward for working parents, but the last thing we want is for a bug to spread across the whole class simply because one child has been sent back to school too early. <u>Juice Fund</u>
