Dear Parents and Carers,

I can hardly believe that this is the final letter of the school year. I always find endings difficult – I just do not like change! Next week, we will be saying goodbye to our Year 6 children, many of whom have been with us for 7 years – it is always hard and it will be a very emotional week for children, parents and staff alike.

We have enjoyed another fabulous week in school with three terrific sports days. I have to say that I think these have been the best ever – the children were fabulous and thoroughly enjoyed the events as well as behaving exceptionally well. Thank you and well done to the parents who were brave enough to compete and I think the staff race will be talked about in the staffroom with great delight for a while to come too!

We have enjoyed another highly successful year in school. The new extension opened in September and what a difference this has made! In October, our Friends of the School was formed and they have certainly had a very active year and been exceptionally supportive. We then had a very successful SIAMS (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools) in December and we have also had our best ever KS2 Statutory Test Results. As you know, the KS2 SATs are a very narrow measure of children's attainment. Our aim in school is to ensure our children have a wide range of experiences during their time here and whilst data is obviously of great importance, we believe that this is only one small part of primary school education. However, our school is judged on data and I am delighted to say that our Year 6 children have excelled this year. Our school results are below, along with the national averages and I am sure you can see for yourselves just how well the children have achieved. This is also thanks to a highly talented and dedicated staff team that we have in school – we are very fortunate to have a motivated staff, a superb team spirit and a team of adults who care passionately about doing their absolute best for your children.

#### **Uniform Changes**

Following our recent parent questionnaire there will be an additional school sweatshirt and cardigan available from Moette ready for September. ## **Nursery Uniform Changes**

From September Nursery children **only** will be invited to wear sky blue polo shirts. However, they can continue to wear their white ones for the next academic year. All children in Main school will continue to wear white polo shirts. School uniform is available to order directly from Moette.

#### **Uniform for September**

All school uniform ordered before 10th August will be delivered to school on 3rd September and will be available for collection from the school office between 1-3pm. If you place your order after this time, delivery in time for the new term cannot be guaranteed. We ask that all parents request that their child's initials be added to the sweatshirts/cardigans as this is at **no additional cost**. Thank you.

#### **School Dinners**

The cost of school dinners increases in September and will now cost £2.05 per day, or £10.25 per week. Our current Year 2 children will no longer be eligible for free school meals once they move up to Year 3 so all school dinners will have to be paid for in September by our current Year 2 pupils, unless they are entitled to Free School Meals. If your child will not be requiring school dinners after the holidays, please inform the office before the end of term. This ensures you will not be charged for school dinners if your child is not having them.

## Monday 23rd July to Friday 3rd August - Holiday Club

Don't forget that Mr Graham is running a holiday club for the first two weeks of the summer holidays. Please do not forget to sign up for this as soon as possible as he is quite busy, especially the first week!

## Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> July - Lanchester Fun Run

On Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> July The Lanchester Partnership are hosting a Fun Run and Family Day at Burnhopeside Hall, Lanchester. The family day opens at 10am and closes at 2pm and the Fun Run course opens at 11am until 1pm. For only £2 per child and £5 per adult, each runner can do as many laps (at a walk or a run) of the 2.5k course as they wish. There is a medal for each runner. All under 12s need to participate with a supervising adult. There will be plenty there to keep the non-runners happy too, so please feel free to attend without running.
