Dear Parents and Carers,

This half term is particularly short and the half term break will be with us in only two weeks – quite a frightening thought! Please make sure that you book your parents evening appointments for the last week of the half term and don't forget that we have holiday clubs taking place in school for 4 days – Monday to Thursday.

Friday 26th and Saturday 27th January - Digital Leaders at the BETT Show

Four of our digital leaders are spending the weekend in London with myself, Mr Knighton, Mr Mordue and Mrs Tatham. During their time at the BETT show, they will have an action packed day, presenting on various stands, and also demonstrating apps and resources. We also hope that they will help us decide which new resources we need for school! Last year, our Digital Leaders were able to trial equipment from 'Now Press Play'. As a result of their enthusiasm, we have now just purchased these resources and all classes will be using them soon – headphones worn by all children which tell a story that the children act out.
