Dear Parents and Carers,

We really do have an action packed week organised for the children next week! I am sure you all know that next week is our Fun and Fitness Week. Please read carefully about what we have organised for the children every day. We also ask children to come to school wearing their sports gear all week. All children, from Nursery to Year 6 should come to school in trainers and sportswear every day, ready for their day of sporting activities. The forecast looks perfect for the week ahead too which is wonderful!

We are also welcoming a group of 8 Italian and 6 Hungarian teachers and pupils to our school for the week. This is part of our Erasmus+ project and the children will be joining our Year 5 classes during the day on Monday and Tuesday. I am sure they will have a wonderful experience and thoroughly enjoy their time with us.

We also have some students from Cranmer Theological College in Durham joining us next week. They are coming to experience life in a Church of England Primary School and will be working with the children during the week.

Monday 21st May - Lions of Zululand in School

At 9.15 am, the Lions of Zululand will lead a concert of traditional singing and dancing dressed in traditional Zulu costume. This is a truly magnificent experience and one which the children from Reception to Year 6 will never forget. We are also asking any parents to join us – the concert will last approximately an hour. Please note, this is not suitable for very young children – the Nursery children will not be joining us – and unfortunately there is no room for pushchairs in the hall.

The concert is followed by a series of workshops when the Zulus work with the children on singing, dancing, Art, Language and Culture. A wonderful day will be had by all!

Tuesday 22nd May – Carousel of Activities

On Tuesday, all children from Nursery to Year 6 will enjoy taking part in a carousel of activities. We have a penalty shoot game, laser run and laser quest on site which I know the children will thoroughly enjoy!

Tuesday 22nd May – Barbecue – 3.30pm to 6 pm

The staff are thoroughly looking forward to cooking for you next week! If you would still like to purchase some BBQ tickets, please buy them no later than Monday. Tickets are £5 each (Adults and children are the same price). However, this year, we are also selling a family ticket for £20. This ticket is for 2 adults and 3 children. Knitsley Farm is providing the food again this year – a burger and bun, sausages, salad, crisps and soft drink. Please help us by buying your tickets before the day itself. All the activities will be on site until 5 pm for families to join in with for a small charge – I am sure the children will be eager to have another go on them all! The barbecue is always a lovely, sociable evening enjoyed by children, parents and staff alike.

Wednesday 23rd May – Year 6 at The Forbidden Corner

Year 6 should come to school dressed ready for a day at The Forbidden Corner. Please note, they will be outside for the whole day, whatever the weather. All children will need a change of clothes (they always get wet from the numerous water features!), drinks and a packed lunch. They will return to school for approximately 5pm.

Wednesday 23rd May – Carousel of Sporting Activities

Consett Rugby Club, Lanchester Cricket Club, Lanchester Tennis Club and Sunderland Football Club are leading a carousel of activities on the school grounds on Wednesday. I am sure the children will love being so active for the day! Nursery will be enjoying their own carousel of sporting activities too.

Thursday 24th May – Year 5&6 Bike Ride

All children going on the bike ride along the old railway line need a bike in good, working order and a helmet. NO children will be allowed to ride their bike without a helmet due to health and safety. If any parents would like to join us on the bike ride, please give your name to the School Office. Please note, adults on the ride do act as role-models to the children so will also need a helmet.

All children will need plenty of drinks and a packed lunch. We ride approximately 12-15 miles and it really is a super day!

Thursday 24th May – Wheels Day

Thursday is Wheels Day for the whole school – from Nursery upwards. We ask all children to bring in a wheeled item for the day. This can be a bike, scooter, skateboard, roller boots, pram, pushchair or any other wheeled item they have. Please note, any child bringing a bike to school MUST have a helmet otherwise they will not be allowed to ride it on school premises. Each class will be allocated a time when they have access to the yard and field to use their wheels!

Thursday 24th May – Hoopstarz

We are welcoming Hoopstarz back into school on Thursday when they will be working with all children from Nursery upwards. Their hula hooping will certainly take on a difference after their great session with the experts! Hoops will also be on sale after school on Thursday. The hula hoops are 36" in diameter, which makes the art of hula hooping easier. If you would like to, you will be able to purchase hula hoops at the end of the day at a cost of £3.00 per hoop. This is a great way to encourage your child to continue to be active at home and for them to be able to show off their new found talent!

Fun and Fitness Week coincides with Walk to School Week so let's all give it a try! I will be walking 7 miles to work on Tuesday morning, setting off at 6.15am to get there in good time. Let's all use next week to get fit, have fun and walk to school on at least one occasion. Not only will you feel better for it, but you will also ease congestion from around the school!

All accounts should be kept in credit at all times to stop reminder texts and letters being sent. If arrears are not brought up to date before the end of the half term, your child may not be able to have a school dinner or stay to After School Club and Breakfast Club until the accounts are brought up-to-date.
