Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing this letter whilst enjoying the beautiful Scottish countryside. We have had a fabulous week in Dalguise, Perthshire with 73 of our oldest children. Next week is another busy one in school with lots of different activities taking place so please make a note of the details below.

Monday 9th and Tuesday 10th July – Year 6 Transition Day at St Bede's

Year 6 children who will be attending St Bede's next year, have two transition days next week. They need to be taken to St Bede's by yourselves between 9.00 am and 9.15 am in their school uniform. Lunch will be provided for them at the canteen and they will need to be collected from St Bede's at 2.30 pm each day. Any further questions about the day will need to be directed to the school itself as this is the only information we have been given.

Monday 9th July – Cricket Tournament

Some of our Year 5 & 6 children will be taking part in a cricket tournament at Burnopfield Cricket Club on Monday. All children playing have been given a letter. They will need to come to school in their sportswear, with a packed lunch and plenty of drinks.

Wednesday 11th July – Foundation Stage Sports Days

We have two Sports Days taking place on Wednesday for our Foundation Stage children. 10 am will be the turn of the Morning children and Beginning of the Week Full Day children as well as Reception children. 1.30 pm will be the turn of the Afternoon children, End of the Week Full Day Nursery children and our 30 hour children. Access to the school field will be through the small gate by the side of the MUGA in the main car park and I am sure your children will all love to have you there to cheer them on! Thursday 12th July at 1.30 pm - Sports Day for Years 1 – 6

As usual, we will be having a small number of competitive races at the end of the event. This includes a mums sprint race and a dads sprint race.
