### **Year 2 Moor House Adventure Visit on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> June**

This year, our Year 2 children have a wonderful opportunity to go to Moor House Adventure Centre. This will be a fantastic trip where their instructors will immerse the children in the outdoor environment, delivering a programme of three different activities which will enable our children to come away with new skills they can use both outdoors and in the class room. The aim of the trip is to help them build their confidence in trying new things, solving problems and building important team working skills.

<b>Time/Duration</b>	Leaving School at 9.15am; pupils will return to school for 3.30pm – parents will be updated via twitter/text message on their ETA.
<b>Venue</b>	Moor House Adventure Centre
<b>Packed lunch required?</b>	Packed lunches will be required for all children – please note we are a nut free school. This will need to be in a backpack so the children can carry it themselves, and they will need to bring plenty of fluids.
<b>Clothing to be worn</b>	Children will need to wear sensible, warm clothes with trainers as they will enjoy a variety of problem solving activities which will be outdoors. They will need a waterproof coat. Depending on the weather they may also need to wear sunscreen and bring a sun hat.
<b>COVID-19 Information</b>	Your child will not be able to attend the session if they, or anyone else in their household, are displaying symptoms of COVID-19. If children begin to exhibit symptoms during the trip, you will be contacted to collect them and will not be able to come back into school unless they have received a negative result from a PCR test centre.
<b>Cost</b>	This trip has been subsidised by the school, therefore we can offer it to you for £20.00 per child. This has been added to your ParentPay account.
