Year 5&6 Residential Visit to Brittany, France

The Year 5 & 6 children have the opportunity of going on a residential to Brittany in France. The children will leave late evening on Friday 21st June 2019, drive through the night before taking the ferry early on the Saturday morning. They will return to school very early on Thursday 27th June 2019.

The Local Authority are organising the transport and ferry while the accommodation is booked through NST Travel, the education travel experts. While there, they will stay at AJ Cancale (for more details see <https://www.hifrance.org/auberge-de-jeunesse/cancale--baie-mont-st-michel.html> and <https://www.hihostels.com/hostels/auberge-de-jeunesse-hi-cancale-mont-st-michel/>). This is the first time we have used the hotel but have changed our accommodation this year as it is highly recommended. The location is perfect as it is right on the beach and within easy driving distance of everywhere.

During our time in France, we will be making sure the children enjoy an unforgettable holiday. They will spend one day in our partner school (a superb experience for everyone), have a trip to St Malo Aquarium and walk round the ramparts before asking for and buying their own ice creams (all the time speaking in French of course!), visiting the medieval city of Dinan, a hypermarket and enjoying a fabulous day in Cobac Parc (<http://www.cobac-parc.com/>), a super family fun park with over 40 rides and attractions as well as having a water park. This park is designed especially for children under the age of 14 so is perfect for our children to enjoy! We will also be able to explore Mont St Michel as well as enjoy some time on the beach.

The cost of this visit is approximately £425 but the final cost will depend upon numbers going. However, it will not vary more than £20 either way and as soon as numbers are finalised, I will confirm the cost. Obviously, this is a substantial amount of money but the accommodation costs £231 per person (full board), the coach and driver is around £4,500, the ferry around £1,500 and then there are entrance fees to the Aquarium and Cobac Parc on top of that.
