The School Meals Service endeavour to work in partnership with all concerned to ensure that we provide specialist diets and menus for all pupils to enable everyone to enjoy a school meal. Please include written confirmation from a Consultant or Dietician confirming the allergy/intolerance as, unfortunately the diet **cannot** be put in place without this confirmation.

Please note diets required for religious reasons do not require medical evidence.

Allergens

Please note all our suppliers are requested to supply nut free products. However, whilst some products can be totally nut-free, suppliers cannot give us a total guarantee that cross-contamination with nuts does not occur during the manufacturing process. Suppliers also cannot guarantee cross contamination does not occur with other allergens that can cause anaphylaxis. However we will attempt to minimise the risk in all cases by providing allergy specialised menus.
