Wednesday 24th November 2021 – Anne Frank Workshop with Year 5

We are delighted to be welcoming Gillian Walnes Perry MBE (the Honorary Vice President and Co-Founder of the Anne Frank Trust UK) to our school on Wednesday to work with our Year 5 pupils. Gillian writes and lectures about the life of Anne Frank and she particularly enjoys delivering workshops and assemblies in schools. Her sessions are unique, as through her work, she had the privilege of meeting many people who knew Anne Frank personally who shared their personal recollections with her.

Both Year 5 classes will be taking part in a workshop with her during the morning session and children will be encouraged to view Anne Frank as a young girl with hopes and dreams, rather than just the author of a diary. Through spotlighting her likes and dislikes and how she felt about what was happening around her, pupils will discuss issues such as the fear of others, differences between public and private writing, concerns over moving schools and making friends.

This is a truly wonderful opportunity for our children and we are sure that they will learn a great deal from the day.
