#### **Foundation Stage News**

Please can you ensure that you take everything home before the half term holiday to allow us to clean and organise our cloakroom areas? This includes PE bags and wellies in both Nursery and Reception. In Nursery, we intend to move the Meerkat group's coat pegs into their group area to try to relieve congestion and make it a little bit easier for children to get changed in the winter months. Can we repeat last week's plea to ensure your child's property is clearly labelled and coats have a sufficiently large loop on them to allow the children to easily hang up their own coats?

In Reception this week, the children have been comparing weights and lengths and developing comparative language. It would be helpful if you could support this at home by helping your child to feel the weight of your store cupboard items and sort 3 or 4 of them by the weight they feel as they pick them up, or by sorting the family's socks from shortest to longest. These practical activities, when supported by you modelling the mathematical vocabulary of 'short, long, longer, heavy, light, lightest', will really support your child's understanding of comparison and measurement.

In Nursery, we have continued to be interested in signs and environmental print. We have been so impressed by the writing that has come out of it! You could encourage this by going on a sign hunt with your child. If you would like to take photos of the signs you see and send them to us to share, please feel free!

Sign-up sheets for Nursery parent chats should now be up on our notice board in the entrance. Parents of children in Flamingo Group are welcome to sign up to see the Nursery Teacher, Miss Butler, but if you would prefer to wait to see Mrs Moran then we will arrange dates after the holiday. Telephone consultations can be arranged if that is better for you.
