## **COVID Reminder**

If you or your child experiences any of the three following symptoms:

- a new, continuous cough
- loss of taste or smell
- high temperature

you must isolate all people in your household and book a COVID test. Your child will not be able to come into school until you have received a negative test result.

Please inform the office via email (<u>school.office@lanchesterep.net</u>) or via the absence reporting line if your child is going to be absent for this reason and inform us whether it is your child or another family member who has symptoms. It is important we have this information for our daily report to the Department for Education and to give us notice that we may need to prepare to isolate a group of students in the event that your child tests positive.

Again, if your child receives a positive COVID result you must inform school as soon as possible by emailing <u>j.davis@lanchesterep.net</u> with 'Positive COVID Test' in the subject if it is on a weekend, or phoning the school on 01207520436 between 8.30am and 4.30pm during the school day. Thank you.

#### **COVID Symptoms in the Holidays**

Whilst we finish for the Christmas break on Friday, it is still important that if your child has a test and tests positive anytime between Friday 18<sup>th</sup> December and Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> December, you inform me on: <u>j.davis@lanchesterep.net</u> putting Positive COVID Test in the subject line. This is so that we can still liaise with Public Health England and Track and Trace. It is also still important that all parents and carers check their emails up until Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> December. Thank you.
