Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been another enormously busy week in school with Year 5 at their residential, Nursery and Reception at Roker Beach for two days, Year 1 at Raby Castle and Year 4 at Tynemouth Aquarium! It really has been quite interesting organising staffing this week with quite so many trips out! But I do feel that is one of the things that makes our school so special. This has also been reiterated to me as I read all the children's comments on their school reports – the things that they have enjoyed about this year are not their most favourite Maths or English lessons – it is all the extra things we do in school that are so memorable for the children.

Year 5 were superb on their residential this week, thoroughly enjoying all the activities and working so well together. I always really enjoy spending time with the children when they are away as you just get to know them so well! I am sure they slept well on Wednesday night and will still be catching up on their sleep at the weekend.

It was lovely to see so many of you at both our Nursery Open Morning on Saturday and the Reception to Year 1 Transition Meeting on Wednesday evening. Thank you so much for coming along and we hope you found the sessions useful.

It is hard to believe that it is July and that we now have less than 3 weeks left in school – and so much still to do! Please read the information below very carefully. So much is happening every day and Year 6 especially need to make the most of every single day they have left with us.

Monday 4th July – Tickets for One Sun, One World

Tickets go on open sale from Monday. After this date, we cannot guarantee every family tickets. Obviously the Empire Theatre can seat far more than we would be able to in school and at the moment, there are plenty of tickets available, but I don't want any child not to have someone there to support them as there are no tickets left.

If parents and carers from other year groups want to come along, then obviously this would be great too. We always aim to do these shows every other year, so their turn will come!

Monday 4th July – Year 3 Workshops with Northumbrian Water

Both Year 3 classes will enjoy some workshops with staff from Northumbrian Water on Monday when they come to school to support their work on 'Flow'. I am sure they will learn an awful lot from these experts!

Monday 4th, Tuesday 5th and Wednesday 6th July - Year 6 Transition Days to North Durham Academy

Those children going to NDA have 3 transition days next week from Monday – Wednesday. The children have been given letters about these days by the NDA staff and they are to make their own way there for these three days.

Tuesday 5th and Wednesday 6th July – Year 6 Transition Days at St Bede's

St Bede's transition days for Year 6 are next Tuesday and Wednesday. You are responsible for getting your child to St Bede's and for collecting them for these transition days. They are to arrive at St Bede's no earlier than 9.15am for a 9.30am start and are to be collected between 2.15pm and 2.30pm each day. I have been informed that letters with this information have been sent to parents. Please note, the children must not come to our school on these days and they are to go directly to St Bede's.
