Monday 17th December – KS1 Nativities at 10am and 2pm

Wednesday 19th December – Foundation Stage and Upper KS2 (Y5/6) Christmas Parties

Our Foundation Stage children are to come to school dressed in their party clothes for their day of fun! Santa Claus will be visiting our youngest children during the day too. Everybody should have received their child's snack bag for party day next Wednesday. For beginning of the week Flamingo Group, they are in your child's tray. If you have not received a bag, please let us know as we have some spares. Your child will need to bring the bag in on Wednesday with some snacks for their party tea. For Reception children and those staying all day in Nursery, we will eat in the afternoon so it does not stop your child eating their lunch. We will provide drinks, so you will only need a few treats in the bag. Our Year 5&6 children can either come to school dressed in their party clothes, or bring them into school and change at lunchtime. I am sure they will all thoroughly enjoy their day!
