## Dear Parents and Carers,

It is hard to believe that we are approaching the penultimate week of term – this year has just flown! It was great to have such good weather for all our sports days this week. The weather does make such a difference! Thank you all for coming!

Next week is a very busy, but exciting one for the children in Years 2 – 6 with our Ocean World performances. Please see more detailed arrangements for the day itself below. The children have worked exceptionally hard for this over a very short period of time – rehearsals only started 4 weeks ago! However, they sound wonderful and you are all in for a real treat! It makes such a difference to be performing it in a real theatre as well – quite an experience for us all. Tickets are now limited and the remainder will be served on a first-come-first-served basis. ## Monday 8th and Tuesday 9th July – Year 6 Transition Days at St Bede's

All Year 6 children who are transferring to St Bede's next year have two transition days on Monday and Tuesday of next week. Arrangements for these days have been communicated to you all by St Bede's. The times are: Monday is 9–2.30pm and Tuesday is 9–2pm although the school has said that because the time for the Tuesday has changed, they will keep the children until 2.30pm if it causes any potential problems. Please liaise with the school directly in the case of any problems. No children should attend our school on either day as there will be no staff member accompanying the children.

## Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> July – Dress Rehearsal for Ocean World

Our Year 1 children are being treated to a performance of Ocean World on Wednesday morning which will be our full dress rehearsal.

## <u>Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July – Ocean World Day</u>

All children from Years 2 – 6 will need a packed lunch for the day. Buses are taking the children up to the Empire first thing in the morning so that a full technical dress rehearsal can take place prior to the afternoon performance. Children will need plenty of fluids for the day too.

At the end of the afternoon performance, ALL children MUST return to school on the bus. Even if family have been there for the show in the afternoon, the children still must return to school. It is a potential safeguarding issue for us to have so many children at the end of the show going in different directions. Please note that this is non-negotiable and no exceptions can be made. Apologies for any inconvenience this may cause you, but it is in the best interests of all the children.

Children should return to the theatre for 5.30pm in time for the 6pm performance. ALL children MUST be collected after this performance. Please be patient with us once the show finishes as we will dismiss children in year groups from the stage and ask parents to come forward as each year group is announced.

# Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July – Digital Leaders at Northern Celebration of Education at Northumbria University

All children will receive their end of year school reports on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July. This includes the Year 6 statutory test results. As explained to Year 6 parents and carers at the meeting earlier in the year, school is notified of the results earlier in the week, but we do not inform parents/carers or children of these until the reports go out. This is so that we can check through the results and papers, ensure there have been no errors and that there are no huge surprises. We also do not want to tell the children in school as there will always be some who are disappointed and we feel that this is in their best interests.
