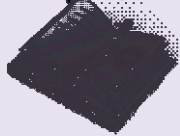


## Communication, Language / Literacy

- Children use their phonic knowledge to blend and segment words with RWI Set 3 Letter Sounds
- Develop two-channelled attention and can listen for longer periods of time
- Can recount past experiences
- Write readable and phonetically plausible sentences



## Mathematics

- Little Big Maths Summer Term
- Confidently use numbers to at least 20
- Make links between different mathematical concepts by working with number sentences involving addition and subtraction using number lines
- Record work more formally
- Quantity
- Sharing



## Physical Development

- Children show strength and control over their own movements through Athletics
- Use a pencil and hold it correctly to form recognisable letters that are usually well-formed
- Show understanding of how to transport and store equipment safely
