Traffic and Parking

It has been a while since I have commented on traffic and parking around school but this week Councillor Mike McGaun and Councillor Douglas Oliver came to see the issues for themselves. Like our MP, Richard Holden, they were quite shocked at what they witnessed. Cars and vans were parked on double yellow lines, cars were parked on the grassed area (opposite Victoria Terrace) and cars were having to mount the pavement, cars were driving very quickly along the road whilst our parents and children were trying to cross the road.

Drivers – please remember that we have access to parking in both the Social Club and the Kings Head Car Park. Please consider using these areas rather than trying to park in close vicinity to the school gates. In addition, when walking your child to and from school, please just be aware of all these issues faced by pedestrians and keep safe. I expect to have further discussions with many others over the next few weeks and hope we will be able to work together to make the area around our school as safe as possible.
