Dear Parents and Carers,

It is hard to believe that it is the final week of the spring term. It has flown! However, we really do have quite a busy week (just for a change) to finish with. Please note we do finish on Thursday and return to school on Monday 16th April.

Monday 26th March - Ceilidh for Years 2-6

This will take place on Monday during the whole day with each class having the opportunity to put their dance and rhythmic skills to great use! I am sure the children will tell you all about it!

Tuesday 27th March - Wacky Hair Day

This is eagerly anticipated by the whole school. Our rota kids are organising the event and it is in aid of a very good cause chosen by the rota kids – Heel and Toe, which helps to raise money and fund different therapies for children in the North East with disabilities.

We are asking everyone to come to school in non-uniform and a wacky hair style in exchange for at least £1. The wackier the hair the better it is! We are welcoming parents, grandparents and families to stay after dropping children off and enjoy a cup of tea or coffee in the school hall, provided by our rota kids. At 9.30am the whole school will come into the hall and join their class on the catwalk (only if they want to though!). The staff will also be taking to the catwalk, even though they don't know it yet! Jenny from Talking Heads will also be joining us to shave the heads of some willing and unwilling volunteers! All of the children's eggs will be judged at the start of the afternoon with some slightly different prizes this year. For each class, there will be two prizes: the best decorated single egg (with no background) and the most creative idea. There is always very tough competition and I am always very pleased that I'm not judging! In addition to this, we have three other egg decorating competitions - one for parents, one for grandparents and one for staff. So get your thinking caps on and start preparing your entries!

Thursday 29th March - Coffee Afternoon at 2.30pm

On the final afternoon, we are holding our usual coffee afternoon from 2.30pm when you will be able to come and see all the eggs, the winners as well as enjoy a cup of tea or coffee and a chat. Our book fair will also be open during this too. We look forward to seeing you there.
