Dear Parents,

As part of our Erasmus+ projects this year, we have the opportunity to take some children from Year 5 on some of our exchange visits. We have two projects that we are involved in at the moment. One is all about the development of writing and how it is taught. This involves eight countries (Cyprus, Finland, Poland, Turkey, Greece, Spain, Italy and ourselves). The other project is based around the teaching of reading, traditional tales and authors in each culture of four countries (Hungary, Germany, Italy and ourselves).

In March, there will be a visit to our partner school in Unna, Germany which will take place from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> March until Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March (depending upon flights). Mr Bailey and Mr Stephenson will be accompanying four boys on this visit for the week. They will be visiting the school in Unna, as well as finding out more about the country's culture and enjoying some lessons around reading, traditional tales and the country's famous authors. Mrs Davis will also be joining the group towards the end of the week for a transnational meeting.

In April, there will be a visit to our partner school in Cordoba, Spain (north of Malaga) which will take place from Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> March/Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April to Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April (depending upon flights). Ms Butler and Mrs Sant will be accompanying four girls for the whole week. During their time in Spain, they will be visiting the school in Cordoba as well as finding out more about the country's culture and enjoying some lessons with children from the other countries in the project and visiting places of interest.

Most of the cost of these visits is funded by the British Council. However, we are asking for a contribution of £75 from each child due to additional visits that will take place during our time there. The children must have their own passport for the visits too.

If we have more than the required number of children interested in going on the visits, we will pick names out of a hat. If you have any further questions about this trip, please feel free to ask!
